

TRANSFER STUDENT CURRICULUM
(effective Fall 2006)

Transfer students generally qualify to begin the Landscape Architecture program in the second year. Those students who are determined eligible, after talking with a faculty advisor, should enroll in the following courses during their first two years at Cal Poly:
